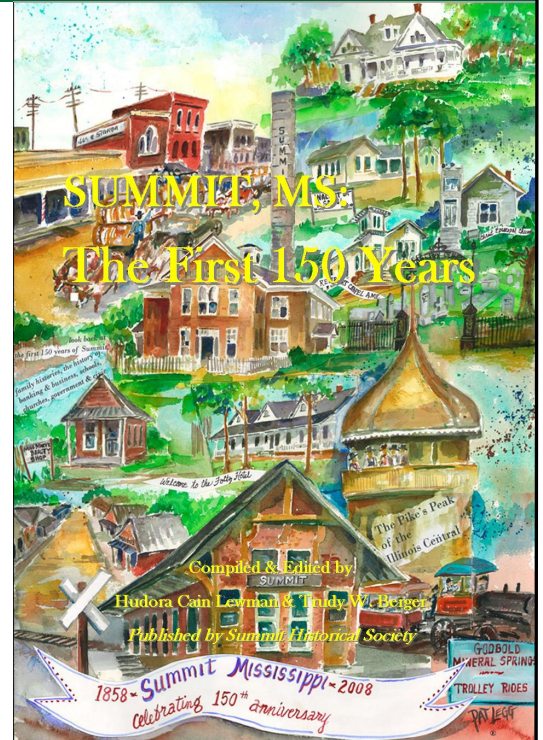


Summit, MS: The First 150 Years
